



Treatment options

 Emollients, bath oils, avoidance of clinically relevant factors, educational program

Mild and moderate AD
 Anti-inflammatory treatment

Difficult to treat AD






less allergens, less polution, more UV exposure, less humidity

systematic review to collect evidence


- trend in data: valuable treatment possibility
- low quality of evidence




Birch pollen 2004


Davos trial

- 88 children 8-18 years
- difficult to treat AD
- treatment for 6 weeks
- follow-up 6 months




Personalized treatment plan: Jonathan's goals

- I would like to be more cheerful (less depressive)





AD severity









